### Meeting Notes:

- Dan started out with the Pledge of Allegiance
- Gary read July notes
- Larisa read Treasurer's Report
- Dan reported on the Gate Status. Said he tried to get the State to authorize having all Sunday and Mondays because of the timer issue. The answer was no they couldn't do that. Then Dan said we might have to give up our Sunday to make the gate work.
- Tom brought up the fact that our Sunday was important to our members who only have that day off to use the range.

- Tom gave the Website update, and said we have 160 paid memberships. He is getting ready to do the 2022 to 2023 new renewals. He also is going to send out a notice to let people know about signing up in October instead of September.
- Gary thanked Builders Choice for their donation of some shingles for our project.
- Gary brought up having a 'Work Day' to get some projects done.
- Dan brought up an idea to donate to the "Clay Busters" trap team to support their young shooters' events. One idea is to hire them to paint our buildings.

- Tom said we need more info on Class Instructors / Members insurance coverage.
- Larisa said she would call and ask our questions, and concerns.
- Casey brought up an idea of the Club sponsoring a Scholarship for a local student.
- Dan said we will have a board meeting on the 6th of September at the Senior Center at 7:00 pm. We will discuss the Scholarship, Gun Raffle, and Banquet.
